Academic Achievements :

Sports Achievements:

Karate Academy:

To promote physical fitness and self-defense skills among our students, we have Karate Academy by the name Tejas under the guidance of our Karate Instructor Mr Gian Singh in our school. Under this Academy , our students have grabbed many medals in different state level and national level tournaments. 8 students of Tejas Karate Academy participated in National Karate Championships in Dehradun out of which four students of our school – Charvi of class 2 , Aanvi Sharma of class 5 , Saarvi of Class 7 and Jayraj Ganpati of class 8 had shown their best moves and stunned the audience and judges. In state level tournaments held at Baijnath Kangra , 12 students of the academy had participated and won 6 gold ,2 silver and 4 bronze medals. In District level tournaments 21 students of Tejas Karate Academy have participated and won 12 Gold medals, 6 Silver medals and 1 bronze medal.

Music Academy

In this session we have started Music Academy by the name Anahad under the guidance of our Music teacher Mr Daljeet Singh where students are discovering their passions and talents leading to a more well rounded education. Our students of Anahad academy are exhibiting their talents by participating in various competitions inside and outside the school.

Abacus Academy:

To develop mental math skills and enhance cognitive abilities in children through structured Abacus training, promoting improved concentration, memory, and problem-solving skills our school has started Abacus Academy under the guidance of our maths teacher Ms Anju Chauhan in last Session and I am feeling happy to share that we are running two batches of Abacus Academy in this session. Our students of Abacus Academy are also participating in National and International Mathematics Competitions and have won positions and cash prizes also.

IIT Madras School Connect Programme

The school successfully participated in the **CODE – IIT Madras School Connect Programme** for the first time, in collaboration with the **Centre for Outreach and Digital Education (CODE), IIT Madras**. Conducted online, the programme provided students with valuable opportunities to explore diverse and emerging fields through courses in Data Science & Artificial Intelligence, Mathematics & Computing, Economics, Finance & Money Matters, and Architecture & Design.

Students successfully completed their respective courses and were awarded certificates in recognition of their participation and achievement. The programme enriched their learning beyond the classroom and encouraged them to develop new skills and explore emerging areas.
